Accessing UC and NatSpeak menus and help

In the next four sections you'll learn how to quickly access any UC or NatSpeak menu item. You'll also learn how to open any section or subsection of the UC documentation with a single speech command.

Lesson 1.6 Accessing UC menu items

In this section you'll learn two ways to access UC menu items:

- 1. Browse through the UC menu
- 2. Quickly access any UC menu item, no matter how many layers deep it is, with a single speech command (UC is pronounced "you see")

Table 1.6a Accessing UC menu items

Say	То
UC Menu Escape 1-10 Escape Cancel	call up the UC tray icon menu close a dialog box or a single menu or drop-down menu close several layers of menus or several screen elements at once close an entire menu tree
UC <uc item="" menu=""> UC <uc guide="" item="" manual="" menu="" or=""> Return</uc></uc>	call up UC submenu items (see Table 1.6b for a full list of UC menu commands) call up a manual chapter or guide, then return the cursor to its original position
Control 1 Control 0	zoom in to actual UC manual page size zoom out to fit the whole UC manual page on screen

Browsing UC

To bring up the main UC menu

say "UC Menu"

To bring up any item from within the open UC menu or any submenu

· say the name of the menu item

Example: "Top Commands" opens the Top Commands submenu from the open UC Menu

To close any system menu or dialog box

• say "Escape" (this has the same effect as pressing the Escape key)

To close more than one system menu or dialog box

· say "Cancel"

or

a number from 1-10 followed by "Escape"

Examples: "Cancel" "2 Escape"
