

Lesson 4 Review Tour: Working with the mouse arrow

This tour shows some of the ways you'd typically use the mouse in Utter Command. For details, see the lesson text or Full Reference of the sections listed in the third column, for example “**UC Lesson 1.1**” or “**UC Full 1.1**”.

Speech On	Turns the microphone on from the asleep (yellow) position	1.1
(If necessary Screen Clear)	Minimizes all programs so you can see the desktop	2.3
Rulers Open	Puts rulers around the screen	4.2
40 By 40 No Touch	Places the mouse at 40 by 40 without clicking	4.2
75 By 75 · Touch Right	Places the mouse at 75 by 75 and right-clicks	4.2
Escape	Closes the Right-click menu	3.1
Mouse 10 Down	Moves the mouse 10 increments down	4.4
Mouse 10 Point 3 Left	Moves the mouse 10.3 increments to the left	4.6
Mouse 10 Up · Touch Right	Moves the mouse 10 increments up and right-clicks	4.4
Escape	Closes the Right-click menu	3.1
Click on any icon on your desktop by saying, for example, 20 By 10	Selects the icon — it should be highlighted	4.2
Drag 50 By 50	Drag the icon to the middle of the screen (<i>IMPORTANT: if you have the Windows snap-to-grid option on you may have to reposition the mouse before dragging again.</i>)	4.5
Drag 85 By 37	Drags the icon near the bottom left area of the screen	4.5
Drag 20 Right	Drags the icon 20 increments to the right	4.5
Drag 10 Point 5 Up	Drags the icon 10.5 increments up	4.6
Drag 20 By 10	Puts the icon back to where it started	4.5
Demo Three File (if necessary Window Max)	Opens the file named “Demo Three” Maximizes window	5.6
30 By 30 Line (you may have to adjust the coordinates for this and the following three commands so that the cursor is placed on a line of text)	Selects the line of text at 30 by 30	4.9
40 By 40 Word	Selects the word nearest 40 by 40	4.9
50 By 20 Graph Space	Selects the paragraph nearest 50 by 20 and following blank line	4.9
This Cut	Cuts the selected paragraph and following blank line	7.8
80 By 20 · Paste	Pastes the paragraph at the end of the document	4.10
Rulers Close	Closes the rulers	4.2
Window Close · No	Closes the Demo Three file without saving changes	2.9
Firefox Open	Opens Firefox	2.1
Under Tango Oscar	Opens the Firefox <u>T</u> ools/ <u>O</u> ptions dialog box	3.3 6.9
Local 10 By 30	Clicks the Content icon to go to the Content section	4.3
Local 10 By 20	Clicks the Tabs icon to go to the Tabs section	4.3
Local 10 By 10	Clicks the Main icon to go to the Main section	4.3
Window Close Times 2 · Speech Off	Closes the Options dialog box and the main Firefox window, and puts the microphone to sleep	2.16
