

## Lesson 9 Review Tour: Working with the Web

This tour shows you the most common and efficient ways to get around the Internet using Utter Command. For details, including commands for drop-down lists and buttons, alternate text capture methods and commands for IE, see the lesson text or Full Reference of the sections listed in the third column, for example “**UC Lesson 1.1**” or “**UC Full 1.1**”. For best results close all open windows before beginning this tour. If you’re using Firefox for this tour make sure you have the Mouseless Browsing extension installed (see **UC Intro 2.3.2**).

<p><b>Window Close · Speech Off</b></p>	<p>Closes the browser and puts the microphone to sleep (yellow)</p>	<p><b>2.16</b></p>
