

Lesson 9.2 Adding Web sites to the Site list

In this section you'll learn to add your own Web sites to the Site list. This will allow you to call up any Web site using a single speech command.

Table 9.2: Adding Web sites to the Site list

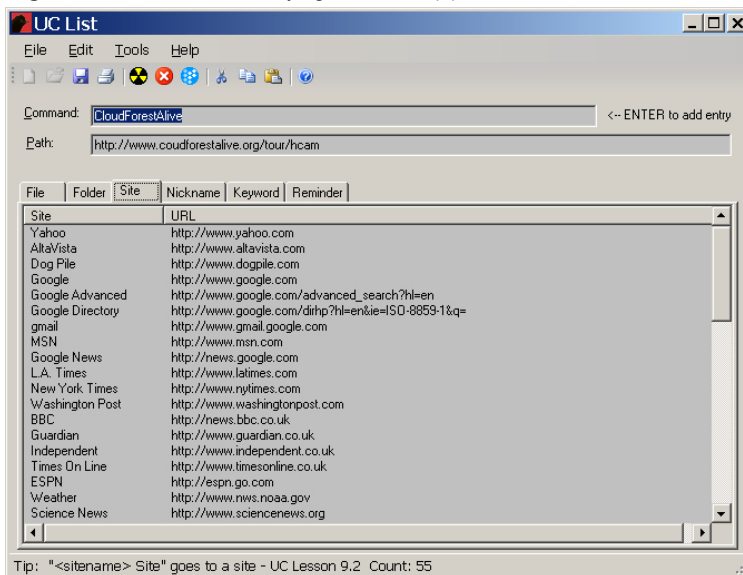
Say	To
UC Site	open the UC List dialog box to the Site tab
UC Site Path	open the UC List dialog box to the Site tab, then move to the Path field
UC Site Command	open the UC List dialog box to the Site tab, then move to the Command field
Add Site	add the current Web site to the Site list
This Add Site	add selected text as an address to the Site list
Add Site Yes	add the current Web site to the Site list, then close the UC List dialog box
Add Site Restart	add the current Web site to the Site list and restart Naturally Speaking
Add Site Do Not	add the current Web site to the Site list without restarting Naturally Speaking

You can add a Web site to your Site List by typing or pasting an address or adding directly from a browser open to the site.

To add the Web site shown in your browser's address bar directly to your Site list, say

1. **"Firefox Open"** (or Internet Open)
2. Navigate to the site you want to add
3. **"Add Site"** to open the Site list and add the address and a default site name to the Path and Command fields

4. If necessary, replace or edit what appears in the Command field — we suggest keeping it simple and calling the site the same name that appears on the address bar when appropriate
